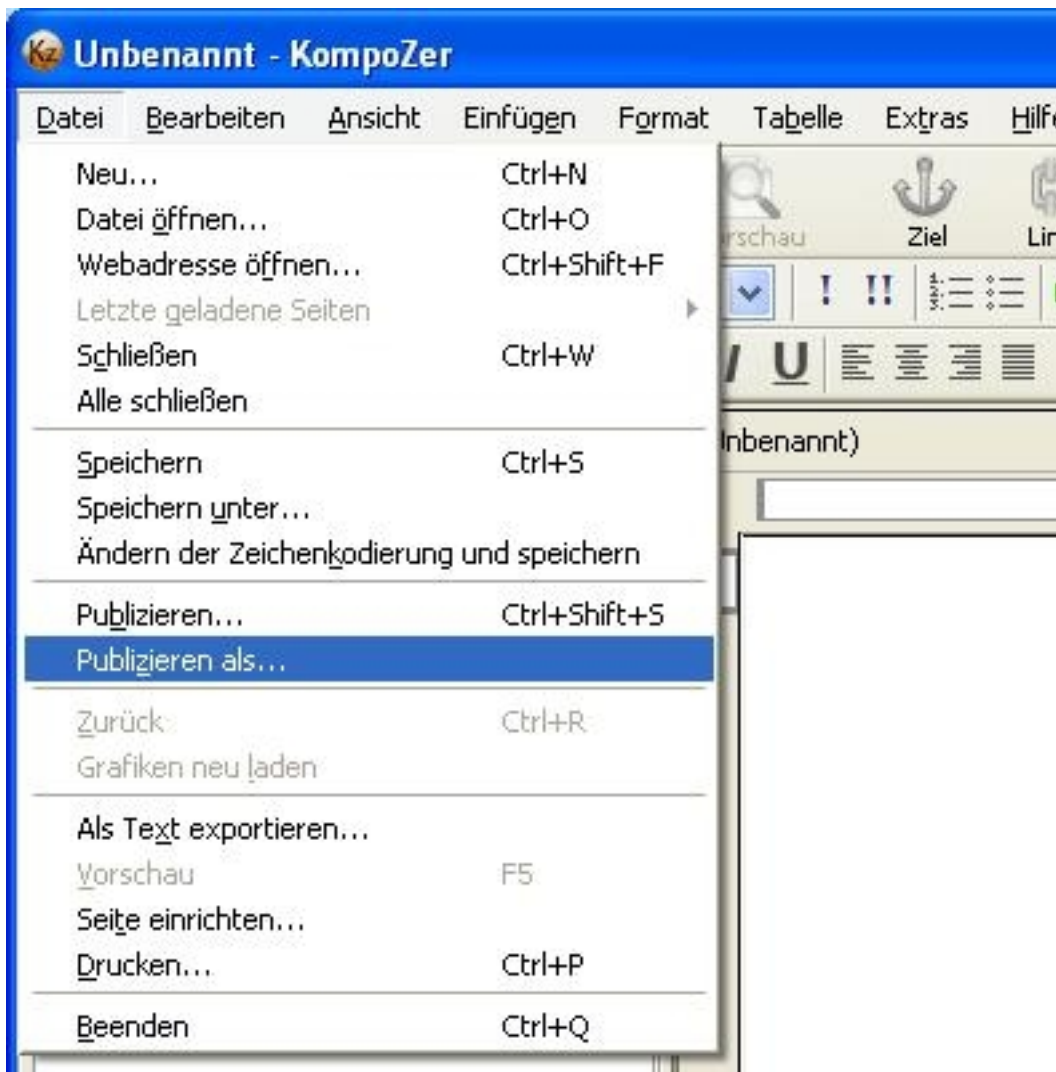


FTP-Accounts

How can I publish my files with Nvu or KompoZer ?

Open Nvu or KompoZer. Under the "File" menu entry you will find the option "Publish as...".



Click the "Settings" tab. Enter the settings you want to save under the menu point "Site Name".
